

PATHWAY FOR OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSES TO GET ON THE HASANZ REGISTER

JOIN NZOHNA OR BE A MEMBER

- Become a full member of NZOHNA.
- Reviewed by peer or mentor using the Knowledge and Skills Framework (KSF).
- Exemplars within KSF including examples e.g. published work/reports, meetings, or presentations to provide evidence of competency.

RECEIVED BY NZOHNA

- NZOHNA member is assessed by an approved NZOHNA HASANZ Assessor at proficient or above (request to NZOHNA HASANZ representative to be allocated to an assessor).
- At least 2 years experience,
- Collate certification for competencies selected to upload to the NZOHNA website on your profile page.
- Level of postgraduate study consistent with the KSF requirements.

APPLYING TO BE HASANZ REGISTERED

- Talk to HASANZ Assessor
- Apply on the HASANZ website ticking only competencies which are assessed by OHNs.
- If you apply for competencies outside OHN core competencies, your evidence will be sent to another discipline for assessment (the HASANZ assessor can guide you with this).
- Once received the first administration check will be done including membership and registration

ASSESSED

- You will be assessed by the second NZOHNA HASANZ assessor. The OHN will be informed of the progress and the administration process discussed.
- Complete the application – click on the complete button.
- Registration fee is paid.
- NZOHNA HASANZ assessor will ensure competencies correlate to evidence and approve once all evidence is received.
- Final review completed by HASANZ prior to HASANZ publishing the OHN on the register.
